Composer-clinician-conductor-pianist Glenn Edward Burleigh is a classically trained concert musician who studied with dozens of distinguished professors and celebrated artists, earning both Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Music. A native of Guthrie, Oklahoma, Glenn Burleigh began building on his roots in the Black Church at the age of nine, and over the years, has served as a Minister of Music and Artist-in-Residence in Oklahoma, Nebraska, and Texas. He has written and published more than 200 choral pieces and major works, and his gospel songs and arrangements of classic spirituals are among the most popular in the country.
